




National Water Resources Management Project Uzbekistan 2015-2022

4 components for intervention





National Water Resources Management Project Uzbekistan 2015-2022

Component 1: Appropriate strategic and legislative framework conditions allow an efficient development of the water sector.

Support to improve legislative framework on water management

- to provide upon demand policy and legal advice for the implementation of the new Water Code
- technical assistance for the amendment of national water legislation, with its acts and by-laws

Component 2: A transparent mechanism for the exchange of water-related data and a decision support system compatible with the regional systems are introduced at ministry level.


to facilitate data sharing among different data producers and stakeholders (MAWR, Hydromet, Committee for Nature Protection, State Committee for Land Resources, Geodesy, Cartography and State Cadastre, Ministry of Emergency Situation etc.) by creating a single Water Information System.

Component 3: Collaboration and capacities of sub-basin organisations in a Small Transboundary Tributary of the Fergana Valley are enhanced, providing effective support to communities in reduction of disaster risks.

- Shahimardansai on Small Transboundary Tributary (STT) between Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan
- to install Early Warning Systems including disaster management, to mitigate the impact of recurrent floods on infrastructure and irrigated areas of the downstream


