Scientific-Information Center on water issues at the Interstate Commission for Water Coordination of Central Asia (SIC ICWC) was established by ICWC's decision of 5 December 1992, SIC is an executive body of ICWC along with ICWC Secretariat, Basin Water Organizations (BWO) of Amudarya and Syrdarya, and Coordination Metrological Center (CMC).

According to the Decision by the Heads of State and the Board of IFAS, ICWC was included in the International Fund for Saving the Aral Sea (IFAS) and have got the status of an international organization.

SIC ICWC is collaborating with a network of scientific and design organizations of the five countries of Central Asia and has national branches in three countries (Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan). In addition, an Agreement was signed with SIC ICSD (Ashgabad) on scientific and technological cooperation.
